

Founded in 1981 by Gurudev Sri Sri Ravishankar, The Art of Living Foundation is an educational and humanitarian movement engaged in stress-management and social service initiatives. A multi-faceted organisation, it propagates love, peace and compassion, and comprises one of the largest volunteer bases in the world. The organisation's international headquarter is located in Bangalore, India. It operates in 155 countries and has touched the lives of over 370 million people.

The Art of Living Foundation runs several stress-elimination programmes to help individuals rid themselves of stress and experience inner peace, which include breathing techniques, meditation and yoga.

curriculum

Noted American polymath, Benjamin Franklin, put it precisely when he said, "Tell me and I forget. Teach me and I remember. Involve me and I learn." Sri Sri Academy's pedagogy is rooted in a balance of academic growth and holistic education to ensure each student's all-round development. Our academic curriculum comprises of a unique set of modules curated by experts that give our students a distinct edge by the time they complete their Grade 12 board examination. By incorporating the 5 C's — Creativity, Critical Thinking, Confidence, Communication and Collaboration, we emphasize on experiential learning rather than rote learning, thereby making learning interactive and interesting.

PRE-PRIMARY SECTION

The pre-primary classrooms have lively décor to make them attractive for young learners. The days of bland classrooms with only a blackboard and desks are passé. Our pre-primary teachers are specially trained to make sure modern teaching techniques are followed. From the outset, we outline that children must be taught "how to think" as opposed to "what to think". This gives free reign to their thoughts much like how the American-Lebanese philosopher Kahlil Gibran had espoused, "You may give them your love but not your thoughts, for they have their own thoughts…"



PRIMARY

The primary school years build upon the foundation that was laid in the pre-primary section. Children are now exposed to an array of activities and experiences as the focus is on learning by doing. We try and create an exciting and challenging environment for our children, and in the process, spark their curiosity and develop their self-confidence. Teachers use metacognitive strategies like discussion, reflection and routine writing activity sequencing to develop critical thinking skills. Students are encouraged to be innovative, analytical, adaptable and to develop interpersonal skills. Strong emphasis is laid on creating a strong conceptual base in Science, Mathematics and Languages.

SECONDARY

At this stage, children will have developed a certain degree of proficiency already – be it in terms of academics, sports or co-curricular activities. Each student's unique personality begins taking definite form. At Sri Sri Academy, we are well aware of how teenaged children may be prone to perhaps

showing streaks of rebellion or feeling confused. We thus ensure an environment that gives adolescents opportunities to grow, learn, analyze and evaluate new information, engage in problem solving and researching and introspecting about life and career skills. We help them develop cultural, global and environmental awareness apart from leadership skills.

SENIOR SECONDARY

Students who join us at the senior secondary level have already cleared the first board exam of their student life. They are now able to participate in classroom discussions, art projects, cooperative and collaborative activities. We encourage them to explore real-world concepts and issues, challenge assumption, think critically and acquire skills that will need to be applied in educational and future professional journeys. Sri Sri Academy offers all three streams – Science, Commerce and Arts depending upon their interests and academic inclination. Students receive added mentorship to enable them to deliver stellar board exam results. We also offer preparatory classes for competitive exams.







DIGITAL CLASSROOMS & WI-FI ENABLED CAMPUS

Our classrooms embody a positive learning environment. They are bright, well-ventilated and colourful with modern, age-appropriate and child-friendly furniture that can be easily rearranged for group activities. All classrooms are technology enabled with LED televisions. These are compatible with our teachers' iPads that help deliver lessons, which are both interesting and informative. The strength of each class is limited to 30 students so that each child receives personal attention from their mentors. Network connectivity being indispensable, we've ensured that our campus is equipped with wi-fi connectivity across all areas. Beside ensuring quick access to information, it also helps strengthen safety and security.

LIBRARY

At Sri Sri Academy, we try and inculcate a love for reading in each child. Our library has a mix of English classics, biographies, science journals, spiritual guides, encyclopedias and volumes on business studies. It has already become a favourite place for many of our students. The library also lends itself to story-telling, group discussions and brainstorming sessions. A qualified librarian assists children with the selection of age-appropriate books. The librarian also organises book fairs and literary festivals.







LABORATORIES

PHYSICS LAB

Our Physics Laboratory is a spacious, well-lit room with wide desks that can comfortably accommodate large instruments. It boasts sophisticated equipment that offer a hands-on experience to young learners.

CHEMISTRY LAB

Our Chemistry Laboratory is equipped with common apparatus such as test tubes and beakers, a wide array of

laboratory reagents and safety features such as fire extinguishers, a first aid kit and shut-off valves. The workstations are outfitted with Bunsen burners and water sinks on either side. We ensure children are aware of the dangers present and strict supervision is maintained when experiments are underway.

BIOLOGY LAB

The Biology Laboratory provides students with learning aids ranging from specimens and models to equipment like digital and analytical balances, an oven, an incubator and thermometers. We also make sure to maintain a high student to equipment ratio.





LANGUAGE LAB

We have a dedicated lab to strengthen the four tenets of the language - reading, writing, listening and speaking.

The Language Laboratory at Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, is the first of its kind among North Bengal's schools. We have partnered with an initiative called the 'Wordsworth English Language Lab'; it hones students' ability to communicate in English with clarity and confidence. The methodology is a blend of instructor-led training in which concepts are introduced and reinforced with a computer-based training, practice and evaluation process.

MATH LAB

A Math Laboratory is a classroom or designated space to teach mathematics in an interactive way. It sparks an interest in numbers, and it motivates those students who have a phobia for the subject. We have also partnered with an initiative called 'Jodo Gyan' to teach mathematical concepts using a variety of age-specific tools and kits. Students, on their part, are encouraged to use these aids to showcase both their learnings and their unique creativity.

At Sri Sri Academy, our aim is to merge the three facets of mathematical understanding – spanning teacher sessions, student practice and hands-on activities. Needless to say, this system has formed the bedrock of modern science and technology advancement.

In simple terms, we hone students' mathematical acumen, and for the gifted few, the maths laboratory is where we practice tirelessly for National Math Olympiads and similar competitive events.

ROBOTICS LAB

Robotics is one distinct technology sphere that has already seen mass adoption in the manufacturing space. Given how India is positioning itself as a global manufacturing base, an introduction to this technology will be an in-demand skill in the near future.


We introduced Robotics at Sri Sri Academy to strengthen students' understanding of this

fast-emerging field. Assembling kits allow them to understand the basics, while enhancing their logical and analytical skills in the process. We have observed that once students realise the scope of what robotics can accomplish, they are left awestruck!

COMPUTER LAB

Our Computer Laboratory is a centre for students to further explore the wonders of this technological marvel. The advanced specifications of our hardware and software are well suited to learning skills such as coding or web designing.

From an economic standpoint, it is India's digital economy that has consistently outpaced all other sectors over the past decade. In case of start-ups that have exceeded billon-dollar valuations, the common feature is they are all technology based. At Sri Sri Academy, we perceive computer lessons as imparting a valuable life skill – one that will set our students apart regardless of the careers they pursue eventually.





leadership

PREFECTORIAL BODY

"Leadership is the ability to guide others without force, into a direction or decision that leaves them still feeling empowered and accomplished." Lisa Cash Hanson. Electing the school captains, vice captains, house captains, sports captains and discipline in-charges, is an annual tradition at Sri Sri Academy. The process begins with the principal and teachers nominating the leaders, followed by active campaigning by each nominated candidate. The students of classes five to 10 exercise their democratic power to elect their house captains and vice captains. Teachers ensure this process is completed while maintaining strict confidentiality.





HOUSE SYSTEM

The House System at Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, helps to teach children the value of teamwork and encourage a sense of camaraderie, identity and belonging. It provides opportunities for participation, competition and honing of leadership skills that boost self-esteem and confidence.

Houses are allotted to students from Grade One onwards. Participation is encouraged through various inter-house competitions in creative and performing arts, literary activities, sports and special assemblies. All through the year, competitions are held and points awarded for each. At the end of the year, points are counted and the winning house for the year is announced, followed by a prize distribution ceremony.

The houses are:

Bhakti (Yellow House) – signifying devotion and commitment

Yukti (Blue House) – signifying peace and harmony

Shakti (Red House) – signifying energy and vitality

Shanti (Green House) – signifying skill and talent

Senior students are encouraged to participate in the broader curriculum by taking on leadership roles within their houses. They may run house and committee meetings, initiate or assist teachers in planning house and school activities, or take on more formal roles as house or vice captains.

CLUBS & SOCIETIES

Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, has different clubs. These include the literary, entrepreneurship, quiz, nature and culinary clubs. The clubs were formed to provide students with an opportunity to complement their academic learnings.

LITERARY CLUB

Sri Sri Academy's literary club offers a stepping stone for students to imbibe the qualities of a good orator. Whether it is voice modulation, pronunciation, diction or audience engagement, it is through the literary club that participants will be able to overcome their public speaking fears or hesitations. The school's literary club organises debate, elocution and extempore contests for our best speakers to compete. Additionally, well acclaimed guest speakers are invited from time to time to interact with the children and share their learnings with them.



ENTREPRENEURSHIP CLUB

The school entrepreneurship club enables students to sample an in-person experience of the trials and tribulations that an entrepreneur must face. Developing a meticulous business plan, or examining the criteria that one must consider when selecting a location, are all part of this club's learnings. More importantly, the club's participants also spend considerable time in understanding why many business ventures become unsuccessful.

CULINARY CLUB

The purpose of Sri Sri Academy's culinary club is to provide an environment for students to socialise and have fun while learning culinary skills. It begins with an understanding of raw material selection and preparation and then covers cooking, plating and presentation. For most students, it is difficult to grasp all the behind-the-scenes work that go into laying out a full meal. Students also learn about various meal components like appetisers, side dishes and main courses. They are shown how to prepare easy and healthy recipes.

NATURE CLUB

The nature club at Sri Sri Academy, called Naisargik, highlights that conservation of these valuable assets is the pressing need of the hour. Naisargik's focus is nature conservation with the help of a 'green force' or students who are nature enthusiasts. The club members are also tasked with documenting all flora and fauna species that are found on the school campus.

QUIZ CLUB

Quizzing is as much an art form as it is a test of the intellect. The primary objective of Sri Sri Academy's quiz club is to identify students with quizzing talent and create opportunities for them to sharpen their quizzing skills. Certain quiz formats are also a team exercise where students realise the importance of collaborating. The true essence of team spirit, however, is most prominently seen when inter-school quiz contests take place.







Sri Sri Academy is North Bengal's first school to introduce wall climbing as a school activity. This feature helps to teach children the importance of responsibility and risk management skills while being in a safe and supervised environment. It is also a great exercise for children of all age groups. Wall climbing involves all four limbs to manoeuvre a difficult obstacle, making it as much a strenuous physical workout as also a mental one.





creative & performing arts

ART & CRAFT



PERFORMING ARTS

Both visual and performing arts are integral to development as much as learning trigonometry and algebra. Children learn both vocal music and also how to play a variety of instruments. The music room at Sri Sri Academy is equipped with a variety of classical and western musical instruments and students are at liberty to try their hand at classical, folk and western genres. They are guided in their musical journey by a well-qualified music teacher certified by the Trinity College of Music, London. We also have a separate dance studio outfitted with ceiling-to-floor mirrors and a quality audio system. The dance instructor trains children in various forms of classical and contemporary dance styles. Our students are so gifted in these areas that when they perform at school concerts and events, the audiences are left spell bound.





SECURITY

At Sri Sri Academy, we understand how vulnerable both boys and girls are. CCTV cameras have been installed across the campus, especially at all entry and exit points, classrooms, hostels and play areas. The footage is closely monitored, round the clock, by the Chief Administrative Officer and our dedicated security team comprising both male and female security guards. Entry of parents and visitors into the school's premises are meticulously recorded. Fire sprinklers, alarms and smoke detectors have been placed at regular intervals and fire and natural disaster drills and trainings are conducted regularly.

INFIRMARY

The infirmary has adequate capacity to isolate or promptly attend to children who may suffer a health issue, sustain an injury or experience an allergy breakout. Common medicines are stocked in the infirmary, and our full-time nurse is available around the clock. Should an emergency arise, we have the backup to ensure quick transfers to leading hospitals we have tie-ups with.

TRANSPORT

Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, provides a comfortable and efficient transport service for its day boarding students. that both parents and school authorities can track the precise locations of the buses in real-time. They are equipped with first-aid boxes, CCTV cameras, speed governors and other government mandated features. Every bus has a lady attendant who remains on board - right from when the first child is picked up in the morning until the last child is dropped off in the evening. Routine maintenance checks are carried out, and transport safety drills are undertaken for both staff and students.



day cum boarding

Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, offers a day boarding facility. It is a blend of both day and residential school facilities — where students spend their after-school hours to complete not only their assignments, but to also upskill themselves at co-curricular activities. These activities are irreplaceable building blocks towards students' personal, emotional and mental development.

After-school activities range from indoor and outdoor sports, participation in visual and performing arts, enrolling in personality development programmes or signing up for various clubs and house activities like elocutions and debates. For students who require extra academic attention, these after-school hours can also be used towards remedial classes.



hostel

Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, offers complete residential facilities to its students, with separate boys' and girls' hostels. The dormitories are spacious, well lit, adequately furnished and are fully air-conditioned to ensure each child's basic comfort even when away from home. We lay strong emphasis on creating a welcoming, safe and refreshing atmosphere. On the same right, we do not believe in offering an ultra-luxurious environment — one that cocoons them in an unrealistic setting. Students are mandated to perform their own chores such as tidying their own beds each morning, and cleaning their cupboards at regular intervals. Boarders are also taken for outings to nearby scenic locations once in a while along with an overnight outing or a camping excursion, once a year. To keep them busy we organise movie evenings and encourage them to participate in activiites such as flameless cooking or baking, apart from daily sports. One key benefit a child derives from being a boarder is the realisation that decision making is collective — whether it is to form a team to play a board game or to complete a group assignment. Another key learning is the virtue of sharing.

mess



field trips

Students from all classes are taken on scheduled field trips. These outings help to place classroom learnings into perspective when students see real world applications first hand. It also helps to sensitise children to pressing issues – from why it is crucial to consume less and segregate waste, to how climate change can be arrested, and why we need to conserve water.

We take our students on field trips at regular intervals to help them augment their classroom learnings. These could be in the form of a jungle safari, a tea garden visit or a tour of the nearby Science City. Much as these outings are experiential, they also help strengthen peer-to-peer and teacher-student bonds. Field trips are an ideal opportunity for beyond-classroom learnings and for all participants to cultivate shared experiences.

Following such visits, students are required to prepare a short essay on their key takeaways. Depending upon what class they are in, the grades acquired in this activity may count towards their final assessment.



DMIT & career counselling

DMIT

A Dermatoglyphics Multiple Intelligence Test analyses a child's fingerprints to offer an insight into each child's potential and highlights their unique traits. This information helps in guiding students towards activities they have the strongest aptitudes for.

CAREER COUNSELLING

Students from classes eight and above, at Sri Sri Academy, Siliguri, are encouraged to speak with the school's career counsellor from time to time. The reason why several sessions are encouraged is because students' career choices can change as they grow older. In addition, the counsellor is also well-versed with higher education institutions both within India and overseas. We make an earnest attempt to identify your child's strengths – both from observation and proven techniques like 'DMIT'. And with a well-informed career counsellor at hand, you can be assured that we take your child's future career prospects with as much sincerity as you do.



admission process

Sri Sri Academy makes a conscious attempt to invite deserving students from varied backgrounds to be a part of our family. Admissions are open from Grades Playgroup to IX and then in Grade XI (Science/Humanities/Commerce).

Admission Procedure:

- 1. Students seeking admission can apply online at: https://srisriacademy.in/admission-procedure/OR visit the school campus.
- 2. The application form must be submitted either online or in the school registration office and registration process is to be completed within 3 days of collecting the form.
- 3. Upon verification of the form, the school admissions office will call the child to appear for an assessment
- 4. The child along with parents will be called for a personal interview with the admissions committee.
- 5. Upon qualifying, the child will be granted admission.
- 6. Admission is granted once the necessary documents are submitted and admission fees is paid along with other mandatory annual fees are paid in full.
- 7. Admission fee & all relevant documents are to be submitted within 15 days
